STATEMENT OF FAITH

WE BELIEVE

(1) The Scripture is The Word of God:

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” “All scripture is given by the inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for instruction in righteousness,” “For the Word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than a two edged sword...” (St. John 1:1, II Timothy 3:16, Hebrew 4:12)

(2) There is Only One God:

“The Lord our God is one Lord.” “For there are three that bare record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.” (St. Mark 12:29, I John 5:7)

(3) In the Deity of Jesus Christ:

“But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus Christ, the Son of God and that believing ye might have life through his name.” And he hath on his venture and on his thigh a name written, “KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.” “...Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures: And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day...” “Who is gone into heaven and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.” (St. John 20:31, Revelation 19:16, I Corinthians 15:3-4, I Peter 3:22)
